



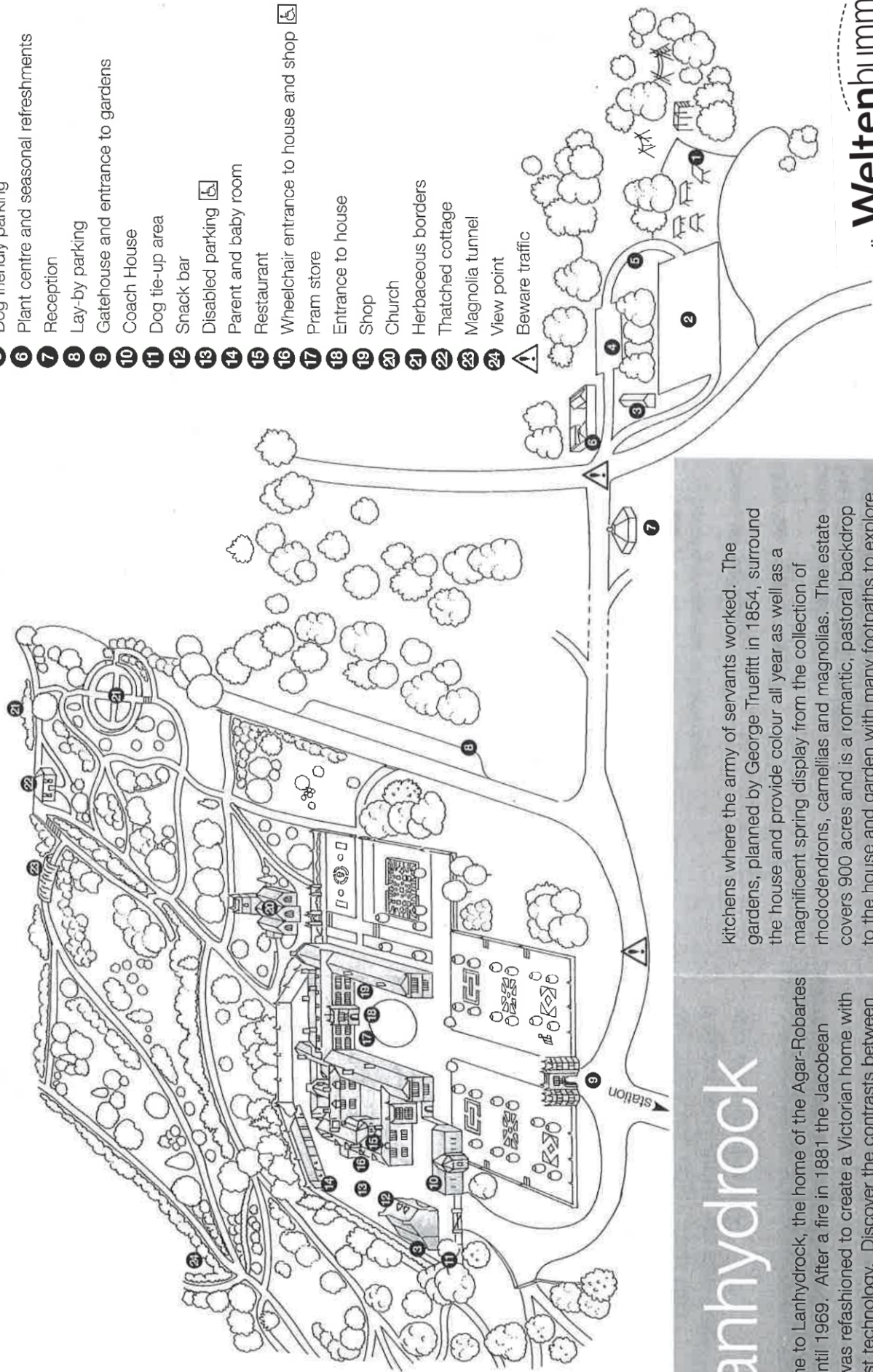

Lanhydrock

Welcome to Lanhydrock, the home of the Agar-Robartes family until 1969. After a fire in 1881 the Jacobean house was refashioned to create a Victorian home with the latest technology. Discover the contrasts between the elegant world of the family and the network of

kitchens where the army of servants worked. The gardens, planned by George Truefitt in 1854, surround the house and provide colour all year as well as a magnificent spring display from the collection of rhododendrons, camellias and magnolias. The estate covers 900 acres and is a romantic, pastoral backdrop to the house and garden with many footpaths to explore the beautiful woodlands and Fowey River.
